



Meanwhile, dog owners can exercise their canine friends securely at off-leash parks such as Casula Parklands, kids can hit the ramps at skate parks like Carnes Hill, and fitness enthusiasts have a number of outdoor gyms to choose from (Woodward Park is a local favourite).

CYCLEWAYS AND WALKWAYS




